- Parking is available in front of the building and the side on Independence Rd. No parking Kenny's Auto Kare parking lot.
- Classes meet one time a week for one hour. If you cannot make it to your selected class, call to see if there is room in another class that week for you to use as a make-up time slot.

Documentation: No dog will be allowed in class without this documentation:

- Proof of health records: Age appropriate vaccinations Distemper combo, Bordetella, Rabies, negative intestinal parasite check within last 3 months (this includes coccidia and giardia) *** Last veterinary receipt should contain this info.
- Application and Signed waiver. **By week of classes start** Classes limited to 6-8. Your class may be changed to a different day if low attendance.
- Payment is due by start of classes. No refunds after first class.

Equipment: Dogs are to be on leash at all times, unless instructed during exercises for the younger groups.

- A 6ft leash leather or nylon. NO retractable or chain leashes.
- Current collar being worn. NO Harness unless veterinary note. Trainer may recommend different collar depending on your dog's training needs.
- Soft bite-size treats, something your dog really loves NO hard biscuits. This can be small bits of hot dog, chicken, turkey, liver, Bil-Jac treats, Cheerios.
- Not treat driven? How about a toy.
- All training equipment is available for purchase.

- Dress:**
- Wear comfortable clothes/rubber soled shoes (NO FLIP FLOPS!). You will be doing a lot of walking, bending, and possibly sitting or kneeling.
 - Avoid wearing loose clothing like scarves, and also jewelry.
 - No cell phones unless you are "on call" emergency personnel.

- Pre-class:**
- Exercise your dog before class. It's not fair to come to class with a dog that's had little or no exercise all day.
 - Limit feed and treats before coming to class. They will be more eager to receive a treat.
 - Limit petting and praise the day of class. We want your dog to seek your attention during class.
 - Make sure your dog has time to take care of his bathroom needs before class. You will be responsible to pick up after your dog, inside and outside the building.

- What to expect during class:**
- The instructor reserves the right to expel owners or any dog that shows aggression towards people or dogs. Private lessons may be recommended in these cases. Please disclose any aggressive tendencies prior to class.
 - Youth handle must be able to follow instruction and have an adult present for all classes.
 - **Week one** –
Introductions start class work
 - **Week two – five**
Class work and homework
 - **Week six** Evaluation! Games and recap over all commands. Trainers will provide you with a grade card and make a recommendation on the next level of obedience.

- Homework:**
- Before the start of class: Research your breed. If it is a mixed breed, research all breeds of your dog and be ready to share information night one with your trainers about characteristic traits and personality they show.
 - Weekly homework sheets will be sent home covering what you learned during class.

- Absenteeism:**
- If your dog is ill please do not bring them to class. You are encouraged to come so you will not get behind.
 - If your non-spayed female is in heat (season) she is welcome with proper sanitary pants.
 - If you are ill please call or email in absent. We will email your homework.
 - You may attend another class within the same week call ahead to verify space available.
